Nearly 200 Attend Public Meeting on Alternate 63 **- Virtual Public Meeting Available On-line**

MACON – MoDOT hosted a big crowd in Kirksville last evening during the second public meeting to discuss Alternate Route 63 and to solicit public comment on the project.

During the open-house meeting, MoDOT staff discusses all aspects of this project with citizens, including the specific details regarding the preferred option for the south tie-in to the Alternate Route.

Display maps, a time-line, cost estimates and a computer-generated simulation showing traffic movement on the Alternate Route in conjunction with Baltimore Street, gave those attending a good sense of the how the project would look once completed.

“We have received 68 comments so far and there is still opportunity for the public to comment through the virtual public meeting on our website, or by mailing in the comment forms they received during the public meeting.” said District Engineer Dan Niec.
