Dear Mr. Keith and County Executive Ehlmann:

I would like to offer my support on behalf of completing Missouri Route 364 (Page Avenue) for which MoDOT and St. Charles County are seeking to secure a TIGER (Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery) Grant.

Missouri Route 364 will complete a missing link in the region's transportation network, which has been planned and supported by local, regional, and state transportation authorities for 40 years. The completion of this project will:


- Boost the distressed retail markets on Missouri Route K a vital economic region of the City of O'Fallon;
- Support local jobs and reduce travel costs between residential areas and jobs;
- Reduce congestion and greenhouse gas emissions on Interstate 70, a transcontinental highway, and Interstate 64;
- Enhance mobility to and from economically distressed areas by improving transportation choices;
- Provide motorists with an alternative route during inspection and maintenance of the other Missouri River bridges;

- Enhance system operations when the deck on the Missouri River bridge on Interstate 70 is replaced (\$70 million, scheduled in 2012) and during the bridge replacement on Interstate 64 (planned);
- Provide a freeway connector from Interstate 270 to Interstate 64;
- Facilitate more efficient freight movement on Interstate 70;
- Provide better access for the region's employment pool to employment opportunities and retraining facilities; and
- Foster long term economic growth in underutilized properties.

The City of O'Fallon is the second largest city in the St. Louis Metropolitan area. Much of the City has developed planning for and anticipating the future construction of this new highway. Many investments have been made by the private sector, the public sector and in particular the City of O'Fallon based on the anticipation of this highway connection. The future success of the City and this region is dependent on this long anticipated project.

Thank you for your continued ongoing initiatives to provide responsive, innovative and cost effective services to the citizens of the City of O'Fallon, St. Charles County, the greater St. Louis region, the State of Missouri, and the Nation.
