PROPOSED AMENDMENT

7 CSR 10-27.020 Eligibility [Requirements]. The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission is amending the title and sections (1), (2), and (3).

COPY

PURPOSE: This amendment proposes editorial changes for clarity and removal of restrictive language.

(1) A sign may only be installed in memory of an individual who died in Missouri as a result of a motor vehicle accident caused by a person who was shown to have been operating a motor vehicle [at the time of the accident] while intoxicated.

(2) [A sign shall not be installed in memory of those who themselves were intoxicated while also operating a motor vehicle.] **Intoxicated individuals killed while operating a motor vehicle are not eligible for this program.**

(3) Only one (1) sign may be requested and installed for [a] **each drunk driving** victim [of a motor vehicle accident caused by a person who was shown to be operating a motor vehicle in an intoxicated condition at the time of the accident].

PRIVATE COST: This proposed amendment will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
