

## RFQ for Potential Site Development

The Pettis County Commission is seeking qualified engineering / consulting firms to meet Union Pacific Railroad rail design engineering requirements for construction of a rail spur.

The design services needed to be performed to Union Pacific Railroad standards include but are not limited to the following:

- Perform a detailed location and topographical survey
- Provide all plan sets (10% Concept Plan, 30% Track Plan, Complete Construction Drawings and Exhibit 'A' Print) to receive UPRR and Pettis County approval
- Develop technical specifications for grading, drainage and track work
- Provide four copies of preliminary and final drawings in paper and digital format
- Provide all required permitting (local, state and federal)

Interested parties must have, and will be scored based on: Prior Union Pacific rail engineering experience; Work history; Work schedule for this project; Demonstrated ability to work within Federal and MoDot funding requirements and deadlines. Each segment will be scored on a 1-25 point basis.

Interested parties should respond with one digital and 4 paper copies of your Statement of Qualifications and a letter of interest to the Pettis County Clerk's Office at 415 S Ohio Ave Suite 214, Sedalia, MO 65301 no later than 4 pm Thursday, December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017. FRQs will be opened at 10:00 am Friday, December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 in the Pettis County Commission Chambers, on the second floor of the Pettis County Courthouse.
