PROJECT NAME: **BISMARCK DEPOT RENOVATION**

Sealed bids for the construction of the **BISMARCK DEPOT RENOVATION** will be received by the City Clerk of Bismarck at the City Hall, 924 Center Street, Bismarck, MO 63624, until **Tuesday, June 1, 2010 @ 2:00 p.m.**, and at that time will be publicly opened and read aloud. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Bismarck City Hall, 924 Center Street, Bismarck, MO 63624, on **Thursday, May 20, 2010 @ 2:00 p.m.** The pre-bid meeting is not mandatory, but interested contractors are strongly recommended to attend.

The project includes: Removal of sidewalk to construct (4) four ADA compliant curb ramps, removal and replacement of a 240' long segmented modular block wall, and limited remodeling of the Bismarck Train Depot.

Copies of the plans, specifications and contract documents may be obtained from the office of the Engineer listed above, upon **payment of Forty Dollars (\$40.00)**, which sum will be non-refundable.

The Owner hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The City (owner) reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive any irregularities in the Bids. If a contract award is made, it will be made to the lowest, best, responsive, responsible bidder, based on the sole determination of the owner. This is a prevailing wage project. State and Federal wage rates will be used for this project, the higher of the two for each job classification should be used.

The BIDDER shall comply with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Contract Provisions. The goal for the **BISMARCK DEPOT RENOVATION** is **4.00%**. All DBE's to be used on this project must be certified and contained in either the MoDot DBE Directory or the MRCC DBE Directory (MBE/WBE's are an entirely different classification). The DBE provisions commonly used are located on the MoDOT website at <http://www.modot.mo.gov/business/manuals/forms>. The DBE submittal forms shall be completed and submitted with the bid proposal or delivered by the low and second low bidder within three working days after the bid opening date. If any DBE's shown on the submittal forms are not listed on the MoDOT approved listing, then that DBE's work will not be counted as DBE participation work and may be cause for rejection of the bid. If the bidder does not meet the established goal, award of contract can be made only if this bidder can document and demonstrate good faith effort to meet the goals. The good faith effort will be reviewed and approved by MoDOT. DBE's must be listed on the MoDOT approved listing at the time of the contract letting (bid opening).
