

## **ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID NO. 3504**

Notice is hereby given that the City of St. Charles will receive sealed proposals at City Hall, Public Works Office, 200 North Second Street, Room 202, St. Charles, MO until **2:00 p.m.** local time, Tuesday, NOVEMBER 10, 2009, at which time all bids for MISSOURI ROUTE 94 AND ZUMBEHL/FRIEDENS ROAD TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS, **Bid No. 3504**, will be publicly opened and read.

The work shall consist of modifying traffic signals, installing a right turn lane on Zumbehl Road and pavement widening on Friedens Road in accordance with the plans and specifications: Missouri Route 94 and Zumbehl/Friedens Road.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, offers, or proposals submitted, or to advertise for new bids.

Any person signing a contract to work on the construction of public works for any public body shall provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) construction safety program for their on-site employees which includes a course in construction safety and health approved by OSHA or a similar program approved by the department which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. All employees are required to complete the program within sixty days of beginning work on such construction project.

Plans and specifications are now available in the Public Works Office, 200 North Second Street, Room 202, St. Charles, MO. There is a **\$30.00** non-refundable fee for each set of plans and specifications.
