**Sidewalk Project – Wise & Safe Owls Sidewalk**

**Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for Wise & Safe Owls Sidewalk, Project No.: TAP-3301(499) will be received at: Marshall City Hall, 214 North Lafayette, Marshall, MO until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. Bids should be delivered to: Marshall City Hall, Attn: Julie Lewis, 214 North Lafayette, Marshall, MO 65340.

The proposed work includes: replacement of sidewalk along the west side of South Miami Avenue from Vest Street to Arrow Street, approximately 1,800 linear feet, and is anticipated to include incidental utility relocations, concrete curb and gutter replacement, concrete driveway approach replacements, street improvements within accessible routes, and pedestrian crossing signage and pavement markings.

Plans and specifications may be (picked up/purchased) for a non-refundable fee of \$75 from the office of the Department of Municipal Services, 1277 South Odell Avenue, Marshall, MO 65340. A pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 o'clock P.M. on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017, at Marshall City Hall, 214 North Lafayette, Marshall, MO. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Marshall hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Marshall reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 4%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
