Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for the Wabash Avenue Reconstruction Project, STP-7302 (648), will be received at: 100 North Main St., O'Fallon MO 63366 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (CDT) on the 9th day of January 2018, at the main front desk of O'Fallon City Hall, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be sealed and clearly marked **Bid #17-041** and submitted utilizing the bid forms provided in the specifications in their entirety.

The proposed work includes: Reconstruction of approximately 1800' of Wabash Avenue between Sonderen Street and Wabash Spur Drive. Improvements include concrete pavement, sidewalk, box culvert and cast-in-place concrete retaining wall construction and associated appurtenances.

A pre-bid conference will be held on the December 18, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Works Conference room, 2nd floor at 100 North Main St, O'Fallon MO 63366. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of O'Fallon hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of O'Fallon reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 12%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
