

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR Bid NO. 4226**  
**First Capitol Drive Enhancement Project**  
**Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for STP-7302(661) First Capitol Drive Enhancement Project will be received at City Hall, Engineering Office, 200 North Second Street, St. Charles, Missouri until **2:00 p.m.** local time, on **April 20<sup>th</sup>**, 2017, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. The bid proposal shall be made on a form of proposal, provided in the specifications and delivered in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside **Bid No. 4226** to the Engineering Office on or before the time specified above.

The project entails constructing new ADA accessible sidewalk facilities along First Capitol Drive from Fifth Street to Alley 7 (between Second Street and Main Street) and on Fifth Street from First Capitol Drive to Madison Street. New lighting and landscaping will be constructed along with the sidewalks, in order to provide a comfortable and safe path for pedestrians. Additionally, a 2" asphalt mill and overlay for First Capitol Drive from Fifth Street to just east of Second Street will provide a new wearing surface for this section of roadway.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of St. Charles hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of St. Charles reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is **13%** of the Total Federal Contract.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
