



SECTION 00101 - NOTICE TO BID

CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU, MO

Sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 401 Independence Street, Cape Girardeau, Missouri 63703, until **10:00 A.M., March 8, 2010**, for the

1,250 foot extension of the existing Fountain Street from Morgan Oak Street to William Street. The project will include construction of a round-a-bout at the intersection of Morgan Oak Street and Fountain Street. Construction will include placement of fill material, installation of catch basins and storm sewer piping, installation of concrete pavement and brick pavers on the street and sidewalks, construction of a detention basin, and installation of decorative light poles and all necessary appurtenances associated with this project according to the Contract Documents for the City of Cape Girardeau.

Under these Contract Documents for the City of Cape Girardeau. Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud on **March 8, 2010, at 10:00 A.M.** in the Office of the City Engineer. A mandatory pre bid meeting will be held on **February 24, 2010, at 10:00 A.M.** at the Osage Center on Kingshighway.

The Contract provides for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for the improvement and construction required per the improvement plans, specifications and construction documents.

A certified or cashier's check, or bid bond executed by the bidder and an approved Surety Company, in the amount of five percent of the bid shall be submitted with each Proposal.

Plans, specifications, proposal form, and contract for said improvement may be seen and/or obtained in the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 401 Independence Street, Cape Girardeau, Missouri 63703. A **non-refundable** fee of \$ 125.00 per set is required. All bidders are required to purchase plans and specifications to submit a bid for this project.

All bids will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the day of the Bid opening, but Owner may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid security prior to that date.

The prime contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. Second tier subcontracting will not be permitted on the project. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to insure that subcontractors do not subcontract any portion of the work.

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law of the State of Missouri, Sec. 290.210 through 290.340, R.S. Mo. 1978, as amended and Federal Wage rates, the higher of the two will predominate. Bidders must agree to comply with all statutory regulations referred to in the specifications. Weekly certified payrolls will be required from the General Contractor and Subcontractors.

Pursuant to 285.530 R.S. Mo, the bidder must affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein by 1) submitting a completed, notarized copy of AFFIDAVIT OF WORK AUTHORIZATION and 2) providing documentation affirming the bidder's enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees proposed to work in connection with the services requested herein.

This project is being partially funded by Community Development Block Grant and Missouri Department of Transportation. The City of Cape Girardeau hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award. Each bidder must document and demonstrate a good faith effort to meet the goal. The goals for this project is as follows: MBE 12.7% WBE 6.9%. The DBE goal through the Missouri Department of Transportation has been set at 6.0%. All DBEs must be registered with MoDOT's approved DBE program.

Additionally, pursuant to 292.675, R.S. Mo, the bidder is informed that all contractors or subcontractors doing work on this project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.
