8. **ENVIRONMENTAL** (added per Addendum 001, issued July 8, 2010)
- 8.1 The supplier shall perform all deliveries to facilities in a safe and professional manner. The supplier's equipment shall be in good working order and all personnel shall be trained in safety measures to prevent accidents from occurring.
- 8.2 The Supplier must provide systems necessary to prevent spills and overfills from occurring during the product transfer.
- a. The Supplier will be responsible for cleaning up any spill in accordance with state and federal environmental regulations.
- b. The supplier must prevent spill from reaching streets, catch basins or other drainage structures during transfers.
- 8.3 A Supplier's delivery truck operator must be present during delivery and take an active part in the prevention of spills. The delivery truck operator will take immediate action to stop the flow of product when the working capacity of the tank has been reached or when an emergency or spill occurs.
- 8.4 Prior to transfer of product and departure of the delivery truck, the delivery truck operator shall examine the lowermost drain and all outlets for leakage. If necessary, tighten, adjust or replace to prevent any product from leaking.
