Genevieve, St. Francois, the City of St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Schuyler, Scotland, Shannon, Sullivan, Texas, Warren, Washington and Worth Counties.** The effective date of change is shown in the column labeled "**Effective Date of Increase**" by the craft (Occupational Title).
