


How to Get Around



1. As drivers approach a roundabout, they slow down and yield to traffic already circulating.

This keeps vehicles from clogging up the circle, and it allows vehicles to enter when there is an opening.

2. When a gap in traffic appears on the left, drivers enter the roundabout by turning right and following the circle until reaching their exits.



3. Splitter islands and lane stripes help keep traffic moving in the right direction.
