## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?**

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to repair and replace deficient sidewalks in various locations along Business Route 50, between Whitton Expressway and Stoneridge Parkway in Jefferson City. The proposed work will reconstruct existing deficient sidewalks and ADA facilities.

### **Why is this work necessary?**

The existing sidewalks are in need of repair and must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

### **How will traffic be affected?**

Occasional temporary lane and entrance closures are possible in the work area during the project.

### **When will the work take place?**

The project is scheduled to be awarded in March of 2016, with construction tentatively scheduled to begin in May of 2016.

### **Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?**

Yes. Temporary construction easement acquirments on adjoining property may be necessary, as well as several small areas of right of way near intersections to accommodate ADA-required improvements.

### **What will the project cost?**

The total project cost is approximately \$700,000.
