The Route 13 Project is a proposed 105.7 kilometer (65.7 mile) transportation improvement extending from U.S. 24 in Lexington, Missouri, to the north shore of Truman Reservoir south of Clinton, Missouri. This project also includes a 7.2 kilometer (4.5 mile) improvement to Route 7 in the area of Clinton, Missouri, from 1.6 kilometers (1.0 miles) west to 1.07 kilometers (0.66 miles) east of Clinton. This project will improve the safety and system efficiency of the existing routes. The proposed improvement will provide a 7.2 meter (24 foot) pavement in each direction separated generally by an 18 meter (60 foot) median. The expressway will use at-grade intersections in rural areas and full control of access in urban areas. The project will be constructed in stages. This document incorporates a description of the environmental conditions and evaluates the potential impact of each project alternative.
