Oversize Overweight Load Hauling

Financial Responsibility

The coverage must be in effect during all of the applicant's oversize overweight operations authorized by permit and cover each motor vehicle operating under the authority of the permit in amounts not less than the following:

Minimum Limits of Combined Single Limit Automobile Liability:

Insurance is no longer maintained for OSOW customers in the MCE system. The decision was made to streamline the entry of applications and the issuance of permits, this eliminated the customer waiting for the insurance company to submit an acceptable filing, and wait for us to work it.

You are responsible for entering the insurance information for each application in the 5 fields available. Because there are some insurance filings still in effect in our files, the system will first check for those and if it is determined that the policy is in effect, the permit will be issued. If the system does not find acceptable insurance on file, it will make the "Insurance Information" fields available for entry.

Entry of insurance is simple. Type the first three characters of your insurance company name and click on the "Company" button for a full listing of regulated companies. Select the Company, the Coverage Amount, and enter the Policy Number, the Effective and Expires date, and submit.

OR you can open a template of a permit that was previously issued with the insurance information completed. To open as a template click on Search on the left side of the screen, enter application or permit number, and click on Search (to the right). Once the desired application appears in your worklist, click on "Open as a Template". The application will open with all the required fields completed; make any necessary changes to the application and click submit.
