

OFFSETTING A ROUTE

Effective April 23, 2014, when entering a route beginning or ending at a junction or intersection, you will need to enter an offset if applicable. An offset is when you detail how many miles and in what direction you are actually starting or ending from your starting or ending location.

See example below:

If you are starting north of the junction 65 and bus 65 in Springfield on 65;

the system will not generate a route unless you enter that you are beginning 1 mile north of bus 65 on 65.
