Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's hearing?

The purpose of tonight's hearing is to provide information on proposed improvements to the U.S. Route 54/Business Route 54/Miller County Route W intersection in Lake Ozark. The proposed construction will improve safety and mobility for motorists in that area.

Why is this work necessary?

The project is necessary to increase the safety of the Route 54, Business Route 54 and Route W intersection and reduce traffic accidents. This work will also improve traffic flow through the area.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be bid in the summer of 2019, with construction tentatively scheduled to start in the fall of 2019. Construction is expected to take two years.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

Yes. We are estimating the project will require the acquisition of approximately nine acres. Based on our current timeline, right of way acquisition plans will be available in late 2018.

What will the project cost?

We are estimating the construction costs of the project will be \$8-10 million.

What is the next step?

Various engineering and environmental studies will be performed while detailed plans will be completed to establish the right of way needs. Necessary property will be acquired through right of way negotiations.
