Temporary Mailboxes



Description

If a customer's mailbox is knocked down during the winter by a snow plow truck, a preconstructed temporary mailboxes can be put in place until a new, permanent one can be installed.. Using a temporary mailbox gives MoDOT time to notify Dig-Rite and the flexibility to do a permanent fix on a better day.

Benefit

This allows for no interruption of mail service for our customers. The temporary boxes are quick and easy to install making it safer for workers to place the boxes after a snow event.

Materials and Labor

Materials cost \$24 with one and a half hours of labor.
