



#### Introduction

Caution, people could be on the scene


Brown Things to do so you won't frown


Orange Means Work Zone. Nothing rhymes with

PUSH BUTTON FOR WALK SIGNAL


Push the button once, and wait for the walk symbol.




It's okay to walk when this symbol is white. Remember, look both ways to see if the street is safe to cross.




Don't walk if the hand is RED.






Stripes point down to the left, drive to the left

Stripes point down to the right, drive to the right


