

Osage County - Route 100 Bridge Replacement over Cedar Creek

Project Facts:

- Proposed improvement includes replacement of the bridge (A1848) over Cedar Creek
- Bridge is located near Luystown (on Route 100)
- Project will be let in required combination with the Route 100 bridge re-deck over Deer Creek, 4.1 miles west of Chamois
 - Only one bridge will be under construction at a time.
- The Osage 100 Bridge over Cedar Creek is included in Gov. Mike Parson's \$351 million Focus on Bridges program, which will repair or replace 250 bridge across the state.

Bridge Facts:

- Constructed in 1966
- Existing bridge deck: 26' width; 185' length
- Approximately 1,848 vehicles use the bridge daily

Proposed New Bridge:

- New bridge deck: 26' width; 200' length

Traffic Impacts:

- Route 100, at the bridge, will be closed during construction
- Construction for bridge (A8890) over Cedar Creek is expected to take 3 months

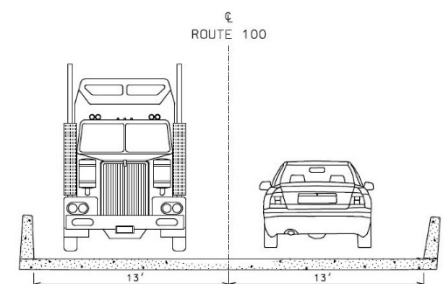
Construction:

- Construction starts in 2022
- December 1, 2022 completion date

Estimated Cost:

- \$1,142,000 (Includes Bridge Removal)
