Iowa	Yes	1 revision before permit expiration. Can amend anything that won't require extra routing.
Illinois	Yes	1 revision before trip start. Can have 1 date extension before permit expiration.
Indiana	Yes	Up to 3 revisions within first 72 hrs. of issuance.
Kansas	No	Changes made on route only.
Kentucky	No	Changes made only if staff error.
Michigan	No	
Minnesota	Yes	1 revision before permit expiration. Can amend anything that won't require extra routing.
Missouri	Yes	Up to 8 revisions, dependent on situation.
Ohio	Yes	1 revision, exc. Load, origin/destination, permit type, Permittee, or fee change.
Wisconsin	Yes	Can amend size/weight, power unit, dates on single trips (unused permit), date extension within 3 business days of permit expiration.
Recommendation	Yes	Case by Case

Holiday Travel Restrictions – No OS Travel	
Iowa	On the following holidays: Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. From Noon on days preceding these holidays and holiday weekends, which include holidays that fall on Monday.
Illinois	National Holidays – From Noon the day before Holiday until sunrise on the day after Holiday *Travel Restrictions apply to all over-dimension loads, except implements of husbandry that are ONLY over width.
Indiana	National Holidays - From Noon the last weekday preceding the holiday and continuing until 1/2 hour before sunrise on the day following the holiday.

Minnesota	National Holidays + Fishing Opener (May)
Missouri	National Holidays – *The restriction for Thanksgiving begins Noon on Wednesday until 1/2 hour before sunrise on the following Monday. *In the event a holiday falls on Saturday, the restriction will apply to the preceding Friday. *If a holiday falls on Sunday, the restriction will apply to the following Monday. *On all holidays, the restriction begins Noon on the day preceding the holiday or the holiday weekend period.

Wisconsin	If vehicle exceeds 13'06" - Operating restrictions imposed on New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and adjacent Friday, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day; restrictions are Noon on the . Independence Day. *Imposed on New Year's Eve, New Year's Day. Easter, Memorial Day Weekend, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and adjacent Friday, *Restrictions vary somewhat depending on whether the holiday is mid-week, Monday or Friday, or on either weekend day. Essentially, holiday restrictions begin at Noon on the day before vary somewhat depending on whether after the holiday. *Opening/closing weekends of gun deer season also prompt restrictions.
Recommendation	National Holidays From Noon day before until morning after holiday.
