

MoDOT Minute – June 21, 2011

Hi. This is Sally Oxenhandler with your MoDOT Minute.

With flooding in the forecast for much of the summer, MoDOT is reminding motorists to check its Traveler Information Map for the latest road conditions before heading out. The map, located at www.modot.org, also lists detours for closures on interstates and major routes. MoDOT continues to prepare for flooding and has moved road barriers and portable message signs to the Missouri River corridor to guide travelers and protect roads and bridges.

The HEAT is On again this summer with High Enforcement Action Teams on the lookout for speeders, drivers who aren't wearing seat belts, and drunk drivers. The three-month campaign will run June 21-September 22 and will kick off with an Interstate 70 corridor project on June 24 and 25. Drivers will see more law enforcement officers on Interstate 70 from 6 a.m. June 24 to 6 a.m. June 25. For more information, visit www.savemolives.com.
