A new highway interchange in southwest Missouri, the first of its kind in the nation, has achieved its goal to move more traffic in less time through the busy northwest gateway to Springfield. The interchange, located at Route 13 and Interstate 44, opened June 21st. It uses a diverging diamond configuration to move traffic through the intersection.
