Dear Mr. Rahn:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the Ozarks Transportation Organization's (OTO) modification of their FY 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of July 1, 2009 as an amendment to the FY 2009-2013 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The modification to be amended into the STIP involves one City of Battlefield sponsored and two Ozark Greenways sponsored bicycle/pedestrian accommodations projects for the Springfield metropolitan area. The City of Battlefield sponsored bicycle/pedestrian accommodations projects will utilize American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funding. This Recovery Act funded project is not located within an economically distressed area (EDA).

The OTO Board of Directors approved the TIP amendments on June 18, 2009. The Missouri Governor approved the OTO amendments on June 30, 2009.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.
