RE: ONEDOT Approval of the Missouri FY 2009-2013 STIP for the incorporation of TIP Amendment #3 into the St. Louis Metropolitan Area's FY 2009 - 2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Dear Mr. Rahn:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the East-West Gateway Council of Governments' (EWGCOG) modification of their FY 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of April 15, 2009, as an amendment to the FY 2009-2013 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment consists of **nine** new MoDOT sponsored projects, **five** new Safe Routes to School projects, **two** new projects funded by MoDOT but sponsored by the City of St. Louis, and **one** project requested by East-West Gateway.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that the *nine new MoDOT projects, the five new Safe Routes to School projects, and the two new projects* sponsored by the City of St. Louis of this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304, and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C.

The Federal Highway Administration denies the incorporation of MoDOT's request to include TIP project number 5122-09, sponsored by the EWGCOG, into Missouri's 2009-2013 STIP. This project is not eligible for the use of Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds, because the EWGCOG does not have an indirect cost allocation plan in place. FHWA recommends that EWGCOG consider this project as an activity in its annual Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), using Planning (PL) funds.

Based upon MoDOT's and the local jurisdiction's commitments found in the supplemental documentation to this action, the STIP amendment request for all projects, except TIP project number 5122-09, is approved.

As required by the 2005 Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) for the 21st Century, MoDOT received approval from Governor Nixon for a TIP amendment for the St. Louis metropolitan area which includes nine new MoDOT sponsored projects, five new Safe Routes to School projects, two new projects funded by MoDOT but sponsored by the City of St. Louis and one project requested by East-West Gateway.
