A project to re-stripe the 13 miles on I-44 between I-270 and I-55 in downtown St. Louis

Project Overview

Missouri Department of Transportation is working hard to address the transportation needs of the community in lieu of the New I-64 project. It is understood that the highway will be greatly affected and portions closed off to the traveling public. In preparation for this event, MoDOT will be re-striping several highways in the St. Louis district. By re-striping these highways, traffic seeking alternative routes will be accommodated. Once re-striped the 13 miles on I-44 between I-270 and I-55 in downtown St. Louis will have five (5) lanes in each direction instead of four (4) lanes.

“We’re re-striping I-44 to help alleviate traffic congestion in the area caused by the closure of I-64 and because I-44 can handle some of the extra traffic,” stated MoDOT Project Manager Jim Middleton.

Crews will begin the re-striping job August 1, 2007 and will be completed November 1, 2007. Most work will take place during nighttime hours but some lane closures will be required during the day. Various lanes will be closed during the project.

MoDOT designated approximately \$3 Million for the I-44 re-striping project.
