

# MoDOT 2009 St. Louis Metro Area Construction Projects

## I-64 RECONSTRUCTION

**1** Interstate 64 from Kingshighway to I-170. All lanes of I-64 and all interchanges closed for I-64 reconstruction work. December 2008 to late 2009.

**2** Interstate 64 at Hampton. Hampton Bridge and I-64 ramps closed for I-64 reconstruction work. September 2008 to July 2009. One lane on Hampton over I-64 will be open in both directions by Memorial Day 2009. All lanes on Hampton Bridge over I-64 open in both directions by July 4, 2009.

**3** Interstate 64 at Hanley. Hanley Bridge and I-64 ramps closed for I-64 reconstruction work. December 2008 to late 2009.

## INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS

**4** Interstate 44 at Southwest. Construct northbound to eastbound turn. Spring 2009 to winter 2010.

**5** Interstate 44 at Arsenal. Replace bridge deck. Drivers can expect lane closures and restrictions. Summer 2009 to winter 2010.

**6** Interstate 44 North Outer Road from Williams Creek to Route 141. Resurfacing. Late winter 2009.

**7** Interstate 44 from I-270 to Route 109. Shoulder repair in various locations along the interstate. Summer 2009.

**8** Interstate 44 South Outer Road from Rudder to Yarnell. Resurfacing and shoulder construction. Summer 2009.

**9** Interstate 44 Outer Roads from Route 141 to Yarnell Road. Resurface outer roads. Winter 2009.

**10** Interstate 44 at Meramec River and Lewis Road. Bridge deck rehabilitation. Will require lane closures on westbound I-44 and on Lewis Road. Ramp from Lewis to westbound I-44 will be closed. Spring 2009 to winter 2010.

**11** Interstate 44, Route 30 to Gray Summit. Overlay. Expect temporary lane restrictions. Summer 2009.

**12** Interstate 44 over Bourbeuse River. Bridge rehabilitation work. Expect lane restrictions. Spring to winter 2009.

**13** Interstate 44 at Route D (Exit 225). Overpass improvements. Overpass will be closed. Spring 2009.

**14** Interstate 55 at 7th Street/Chouteau. Replace signals at I-55 and 7th. Cost share with St. Louis City. Winter to summer 2009.

**15** Interstate 55 at Lafayette. Bridge deck rehabilitation and sidewalk improvements. Drivers can expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Spring 2009 to winter 2010.

**16** Interstate 55. Deck rehabilitation on six bridges, sidewalk improvements. Drivers can expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Spring 2009 to winter 2010.

**17** Interstate 55 from 4500 South Broadway to Lindbergh. Union Bridges replacement, Holly Hills and Delor rehabilitation and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrade of the Bowen pedestrian bridge. Union Bridges will be closed in Spring 2010. Starts in fall 2009.

**18** Interstate 55 at Route M. Interchange modification of southbound I-55. Relocate weigh station. Winter 2009.

**19** Interstate 55, Route M to St. Genevieve county line. Resurfacing. Temporary lane closures. Summer 2009.

**20** Interstate 55 at various locations. Bridge work on Route TT, Route 61 and Isle Dubois creek. Permanent lane restrictions. Spring to summer 2009.

**21** Interstate 64, 7th Street to 14th Street. Seismic retrofitting. Summer 2009 to summer 2011.

**22** Interstate 64 at 9th Street. Poplar Street Bridge deck work and seismic retrofitting. Drivers can expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Summer to fall 2009.

**23** Interstate 64 at the 22nd Street ramp. Seismic work. Summer 2009 to summer 2011.

**24** Interstate 64 at eastbound Vandeventer. Structural repairs. Drivers can expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Summer 2009 to winter 2010.

**25** Interstate 64, Taylor to Vandeventer. Pavement overlay and guardrail. Expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Summer 2009 to winter 2010.

**26** Interstate 64/Route 40 at Spirit of St. Louis Blvd. Add entrance and exit ramps, April 2009 to fall 2009.

**27** Interstate 70, Poplar Street Bridge to I-44/55. Install median barrier, signs, guardrail and curbs. Winter to summer 2010.

**28** Interstate 70 outer road (Memorial Drive) from Poplar Street Bridge to Washington Ave. Pavement replacement, drainage, signs. Winter to summer 2010.

**29** Interstate 70 at the Broadway-Cole Street Viaduct. Seal deck, paint outside girders and clean out drains. Summer to fall 2009.

**30** Interstate 70 Outer Roads. Resurfacing on various outer road sections. Includes pavement repair and shoulder resurfacing on Earth City Expressway and ramps. Summer to fall 2009.

USING THIS MAP

**31** Interstate 70 from 5th Street to Route 61. Upgrade traffic signal systems along outer roads and ramps. Non-peak lane closures. Winter 2009 to fall 2009.

**32** Interstate 70 Outer Road between Route 79 and Route K. Asphalt overlay. Outer roads restricted to one traffic lane with flagger. Summer 2009 to fall 2009.

**33** Interstate 70 from west of Route K to Lake St. Louis Blvd. Remove and replace asphalt. Non-peak lane closures. Spring 2009 to summer 2009.

**34** Interstate 255 Outer Road resurfacing (Kinwood and Barracksview). Roadway resurfacing. Starts summer 2009.

## U.S. HIGHWAYS

**35** Route 40/61 (I-64) from Route K to I-70. Install traffic cameras, sensors and message boards. Lane closures during non-peak times. Spring 2009 to fall 2009.

**35** Route 40/61. Upgrade to I-64 from west of Lake St. Louis Blvd. to I-70. Will eliminate all at-grade crossings and construct a new interchange at Prospect Road. Permanent road closures and some non-peak lane closures. Fall 2007 to fall 2009.

**37** Route 50 from Route 47 to E. Denmark Road. Road widening. Expect temporary lane restrictions. Spring to winter 2009.

**38** Route 61 north of Route A to Route W. Asphalt overlay on outer road segments, pave commuter parking lot at Route P, provide lighting at several intersections. Lane closures (with flaggers) on outer roads, lane closures on Route 61 during lighting work. Spring 2009 to summer 2009.

**39** Route 61, I-55 to Route OO. Resurfacing. Expect permanent lane restrictions. Summer 2009.

**40** Route 61/67 (Lindbergh Blvd.) from Page to Manchester. Replace sidewalk ramps. Starts fall 2009.

**41** Route 61/67 at Telegraph. Signal replacement. Late winter 2008.

**42** Route 67 from I-270 to Route AC (New Halls Ferry Road). Resurfacing. Summer 2008 to summer 2009.

**43** Route 67, Festus to St. Francois County line. Install guard cable. Expect temporary closures. Winter to fall 2009.

## STATE NUMBERED HIGHWAYS

**44** Route 21 bridge over Meramec River. Asphalt bridge deck. Starts summer 2009.

**45** Old Route 21, Lake Lorraine to Route A. Resurfacing. Expect temporary lane closures. Spring to summer 2009.

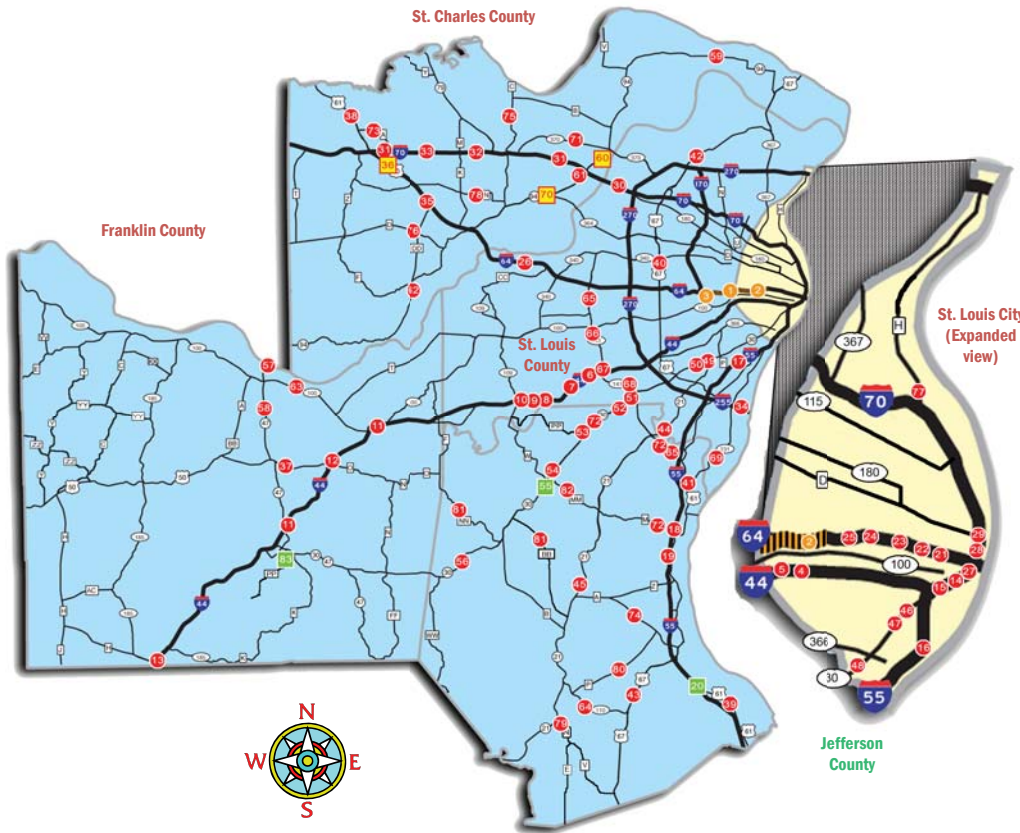
**46** Route 30 at Jefferson. Signal replacement. Winter to summer 2009.

**47** Route 30 at Grand. Signal replacement. Winter to summer 2009.

**48** Route 30 at Loughborough. Signal replacement. Winter to summer 2009.

**49** Route 30 at Route 21. Route 30 widening for dual northbound left turns onto Route 21 and adding a right turn lane for eastbound Route 30. Late winter 2009.

**50** Route 30 at Gravois Creek. This project will replace the bridge at Gravois Creek near Grants Farm. The bridge will include eastbound and westbound turn lanes for Grant/ McNary Roads. The bridge will close February to April 2009. December 2008 to early summer 2009.



**51** Route 30 at Delores Dr. Signal replacement. Summer 2009.

**52** Route 30 bridge over Saline Creek. Repair and resurface both bridges. Summer 2009.

**53** Route 30 at Route PP. Intersection improvements. Summer 2009.

**54** Route 30 bridge over Heads Creek. Rehabilitate westbound lanes of bridge. Winter 2009.

**55** Route 30 at Dulin Creek. Bridge work. Expect permanent lane restrictions. Spring 2009.

**56** Route 30, Route B to Franklin County line. Resurfacing. Expect temporary lane closures. Spring to summer 2009.

**57** Route 47 over Missouri River. Bridge rehabilitation. Expect lane restrictions. Spring to winter 2009.

**58** Route 47 at Country Club. Add turn lanes. Expect temporary lane closures. Summer to fall 2009.

**59** Route 94 from Route H/Route J to Route 67. Resurfacing. Summer to fall 2009.

**60** Route 94 from 5th Street to Route B. Pavement repair and asphalt overlay. Reduce to one lane for pavement repair and overlay work with flaggers. Summer 2009 to fall 2009.

**61** Route 94 outer road segments east and west of Zumbuhl. Asphalt overlays. Outer roads reduced to one lane with flaggers. Spring 2009.

**62** Route 94 north of Defiance. Bridge rehabilitation over Femme Osage Creek. Permanent reductions to one lane with temporary traffic signal. Summer 2009 to fall 2009.

**63** Route 100, I-44 to Washington. Construct additional lanes. Temporary lane closures. Summer 2008 to summer 2010.

**64** Route 110, Route 67 to Route 21. Resurfacing. Expect temporary lane closures. Spring to summer 2009.

**65** Route 141 from Interstate 64 to Route 61/67. Install traffic cameras and sensors. Fall 2009.

**66** Route 141 Outer Road south of Manchester. Meramec Station Road will be closed south of Manchester for bridge rehabilitation. February 2009 to summer 2009.

**67** Route 141 at Interstate 44. Commuter lot expansion. Summer 2009.

**68** Route 141 and Centurion. Construct a northbound right turn lane at Centurion and install a message board on Route 141 at Bowles to alert drivers of roadway incidents. Starts fall 2009.

**69** Route 231 from Christopher to north of Meramec River. Resurfacing. Spring to summer 2009.

**70** Route 364 east and west of Harvester Road. Upgrade Route 94 to a limited access roadway with an overpass for Harvester Road and one-way outer roads. Permanent lane restrictions and some

non-peak lane closures. Includes weekend and day work. Fall 2007 to fall 2009.

**71** Route 370 from Missouri River to Interstate 70. Install traffic cameras, sensors and message boards. Non-peak lane closures. Winter 2009 to fall 2009.

**72** Various routes. Add lighting and improvements to Route 141 at Old Missouri Road, Route 30 at Main and Route M at Catlin. Winter 2009.

## STATE LETTERED HIGHWAYS

**73** Route A from Interstate 70 to Route 61. Pavement rehab work and asphalt overlay. Non-peak lane closures. Summer 2009 to fall 2009.

**74** Route A, Route 21 to Collins Road. Resurfacing. Expect temporary lane closures. Fall 2009.

**75** Route C from Interstate 70 to the Mississippi River. Asphalt overlay. Reduction to one lane with flaggers during non-peak hours. Summer 2009.

**76** Route D from Callaway Fork road west 1.2 miles. Add shoulders. Reduction to one lane with flaggers during non-peak hours. Spring 2009.

**77** Route H at Adelaide. Remove and replace bridge deck. Expect lane closures and permanent restrictions. Fall 2009 to fall 2011.

**78** Route N from Meadowlake to Round Tower. Raise and realign roadway. Travelers can expect reduced lane widths and traffic bypasses. Non-peak lane closures. Summer 2009 to winter 2010.

**79** Route N, Donelly to Route 21. Resurfacing. Expect temporary lane closures. Spring 2009.

**80** Route P. Replace culverts. Daily road closures. Summer to fall 2009.

**81** Route BB and Route NN. Overlay. Expect temporary lane closures. Spring to summer 2009.

**82** Route MM from Buckeye Valley to Geerdes Road. Safety improvement. Route MM will be straightened and widened to include a shoulder. Four turn lanes will be added along the Route. Starts spring 2009.

**83** Route PP at Hoosier Creek. Bridge work. Expect permanent lane restrictions. Spring to summer 2009.

**Please Note:** This map shows only major construction projects in the St. Louis metro area. Construction and maintenance work will occur on other roadways throughout the area. Many projects will include lane closures, and delays can be expected any time during the duration of a project. Completion dates are subject to change.

## Best of both Worlds

As you travel through the St. Louis region, get the latest information on traffic patterns, construction and how to get where you are going, especially as the I-64 reconstruction project continues into its second year. Work zones can be an inconvenience, but they mean MoDOT is making the roads **SMOOTHER** and **SAFER** for you as **SOON** as possible. Here are some tools to use to get an edge on travel as you drive around St. Louis.



At home or on the road, MoDOT's Traveler Information Map and Gateway Guide help give the drivers in the St. Louis metropolitan area two ways to get the latest in travel information. The Traveler Information Map, at [www.modot.org](http://www.modot.org), uses icons to identify work zones, road closures, incidents, flooded roads and winter road conditions. Additionally, electronic message boards along Interstate 70 and Interstate 44 give drivers information on uncommon road conditions, crashes or construction. Additionally, drivers can get Amber or SARAA alerts for missing children.



Drivers can supplement that information with Gateway Guide, a transportation communication network that helps reduce congestion and improve safety throughout the St. Louis metropolitan region. The system gets real-time traffic data -- to include traffic speeds, crashes and roadwork -- and provides this real-time information in easy to access formats to drivers in the region. With more cameras, more sensors and more overhead message boards, Gateway Guide gives drivers around the metropolitan area more options to make intelligent decisions about their travel plans.

Drivers can use Gateway Guide by:

- **Computer** - at home or on the move, drivers can find out traffic speeds and congestion information by going to [www.gatewayguide.com](http://www.gatewayguide.com). Drivers can evaluate their commute and see which alternate routes may be available. More traffic cameras on more routes give drivers an up-to-the-minute view of the roadway and potential backups.
- **Phone** - Gateway Guide is enhanced by a free 511 service throughout St. Louis on most cellular phone and many home service providers. 511 gives travelers real-time updates on incidents and traffic conditions regional interstates around the clock. For phones which do not have 511 service activated by the carrier, dial 1-877-478-5511 (4STL511). Although the call is free, carrier minute charges may still apply.
- **On the Road** - Drivers can get the most recent information on crashes and travel times by reading the messages on overhead message boards conveniently located on the roads around the metropolitan area. Drivers can use this information to get information on upcoming roadway issues in time to make decisions about choosing alternate routes.



During the I-64 reconstruction, drivers can find alternative routes around highway and ramp closures in St. Louis City and St. Louis County by using Map My Trip. Located at [www.modot.org/stlouis/](http://www.modot.org/stlouis/), Map My Trip provides simple, street-by-street alternate routes when you provide your starting point and destination. Information on Map My Trip changes regularly -- to best use it, drivers should check their route the morning they travel.

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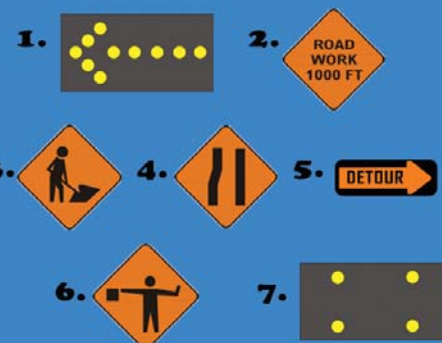
