LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 16, 2009

MADISON COUNTY

- I-55** I-55, from 1.0 mile north of I-270 to 0.3 mile north of IL 4, will be intermittently restricted during daytime hours only until Thursday, December 31, 2009, weather permitting. These lane closures are necessary for geotechnical investigations for the proposed roadway rubbilization project.
- I-55/70** Interstate 55/70 will have lane closures at the interchange with IL 159 continuing through November, 2009. One lane may be closed in each direction during off-peak traffic hours, weather permitting. Peak traffic hours are 6:00 am to 9:00 am in the westbound direction and from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm in the eastbound direction. No lane closures will be in place during these peak traffic hours. These lane closures are necessary in order to repair the driving surface under the IL 159 bridge.
- I-55/70** Rehabilitation of the interchange of I-55/70 and IL Rte. 162 near Troy continues. The project will be utilized for the removal of the existing bridge at the interchange, construction of a new bridge, and a single-point interchange to increase the fluid movement of traffic through this area. In addition, the existing frontage roads will be relocated, new traffic signals will be added, and the installation of new lighting will accommodate the entire interchange reconstruction project. Intermittent lane restrictions will be encountered on both IL Rte. 162 and on I-55/70 during construction. Work on the project is estimated to be completed by late summer, 2012.
- I-70** Lane restrictions will be encountered on westbound I-70 at Highland Silver Lake, approximately 3 miles east of IL 143, beginning Monday, November 16, 2009. The right lane of westbound I-70 will be closed at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, November 16, 2009, weather permitting. The lane closure is needed to perform bridge deck patching. The right lane of westbound I-70 will be re-opened to traffic on Friday, November 20, 2009, at 1:00 p.m. The left lane of westbound I-70 will remain open during this work. It is anticipated this work will be completed November 20, 2009.
- U.S. 67** Daily lane restrictions will be encountered through November 25, 2009 on U.S. Rte. 67 between 3rd Street and Godfrey Road in Alton. These lane restrictions are necessary to perform patching and resurfacing work.

- IL 3** Lane restrictions will be encountered along Illinois Route 3 over Piasa Creek near Godfrey. The project is being completed in two stages utilizing traffic signals to maintain two way traffic. These lane restrictions are needed to replace the existing bridge, and work is to be completed by July, 2010.
- IL 111** Lane and ramp closures will be encountered on northbound IL 111 at the interchange with I-270 near Pontoon Beach, weather permitting. These closures are necessary to replace the damaged concrete pavement on IL 111 and on the adjacent ramp. Traffic will be rerouted by utilizing a marked detour along I-270 and IL 157. This northbound driving lane and westbound I-270 ramp are scheduled to be closed beginning Monday, November 16, 2009 at 7:00 a.m. The estimated completion date is November 25, 2009.
- IL 111** One lane of IL 111 will be closed during daylight hours between Bunkum Road and St. Clair Avenue. The lane closure is necessary to replace the asphalt surface. This work is anticipated to be completed by November 16, 2009.
- IL 160** Lane closures are occurring on IL 160. These lane closures are needed to replace pipe culvert, patching, curb and gutter, sidewalk, electrical work, milling, and resurfacing. Two lane traffic will be maintained throughout the project with flaggers controlling traffic as necessary. It is estimated that the entire project should be completed by November, 2009.
- IL 162** Rehabilitation of the interchange of I-55/70 and IL Rte. 162 near Troy has begun. The project will be utilized for the removal of the existing bridge at the interchange, construction of a new bridge, and a single-point interchange to increase the fluid movement of traffic through this area. In addition, the existing frontage roads will be relocated, new traffic signals will be added, and the installation of new lighting will accommodate the entire interchange reconstruction project. Intermittent lane restrictions will be encountered on both IL Rte. 162 and on I-55/70 during construction. Work on the project is estimated to be completed by late summer, 2012.
- IL 203** Daytime lane restrictions will be encountered along east and westbound Illinois Route 203, from Illinois Route 162 in Granite City to Eagle Park Road in Madison. One lane in each direction will be closed to repair the existing pavement and also to remove and replace the asphalt surface course. Work is expected to be completed by November, 2009.
- Wenzel Rd.** A relocation of the work zone closure on Wenzel Road. This stage of construction will be for the realignment of Wenzel Road from Cabin Club Road to Watt Lane. All traffic north of Cabin Club Road will have to enter from Seiler Road, and traffic south of Watt Lane will require entering from Roach Road. A marked detour route will be maintained around the work zone with detour signs. The project has an estimated completion date of June 2010.

ST. CLAIR COUNTY

- I-64** Nightly lane closures (weeknights 6:00 pm to 4:30 am) will be encountered along I-64 from Green Mount Road to IL Rte. 4. These lane restrictions are needed for installation of High Tension Cable median barrier. Work should be completed by November 30, 2009, weather permitting.
- I-64** There will be lane closures on I-64 from west of IL 4 to east of the Clinton County line. All eastbound lanes between IL 158 and IL 4 will remain open between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. These lane closures are necessary to perform pavement patching, resurface the existing pavement, and perform bridge deck repairs. Please observe caution when travelling through this area. It is estimated that the project will be completed by December 1, 2009.
- U.S.50** Construction has begun on U.S. 50 between South Lincoln Avenue and Annie Street in O'Fallon. Lane closures will be utilized to repair the pavement and resurface the existing roadway. Two-way traffic will be maintained using flaggers and traffic control devices. This work is estimated to be completed by the end of November, 2009.
- IL 3** Lane closures will be encountered on IL 3 from the I-70 ramps to Stolle Road. The lane closures are needed to repair the pavement and resurface the existing roadway. Two-way traffic will be maintained using flaggers and traffic control devices. This work is estimated to be completed by the end of November, 2009.
- IL 4/15** A runaround pavement will be utilized to divert traffic around the bridge to be replaced on IL 4/15 over the Kaskaskia River Overflow. This 2 lane, 2-way runaround will be in use.. It will remain in use until the completion of the new bridge which is estimated to be mid-summer 2010.
- IL 13** Lane closures will be encountered on IL 13 from Nocturne Drive to IL 15. The lane closures are needed to repair the pavement and resurface the existing roadway. Two-way traffic will be maintained using flaggers and traffic control devices. This work is estimated to be completed by the end of November, 2009.
- IL 15** Lane closures will be encountered on IL 15 from just east of IL 159 to just west of Greenmount Road. The lane closures are needed to repair the pavement and resurface the existing roadway. Two-way traffic will be maintained using flaggers and traffic control devices. This work is estimated to be completed by the end of November, 2009.
- IL 15** Lane closures will be encountered on IL 15 from the I-70 ramps to just north of Grand Avenue in East St. Louis. These lane closures are needed to repair the

pavement and resurface the existing roadway. Work is estimated to be completed by the end of November, 2009.

IL 157 Intermittent lane closures will occur on IL 157 from IL Rte. 3 to I-255 in Cahokia. The lane closures are needed for roadway improvements to construct a new bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad and traffic signal improvements. Work should be completed by mid-summer, 2010.

IL 158 Construction will occur at the intersection of IL 158 and Seibert Road near Shiloh. Two lanes will remain open on IL 158 in each direction during construction. The construction consists of intersection improvements, lane widening, resurfacing, and new signals. Work on the project is estimated to be completed by May 31, 2010.

IL 163 Intermittent lane closures will occur on IL 163 in Millstadt, weather permitting. Lane closures are needed to install storm sewers, adjust profile grade through the Zingg Road intersection, realign Mine Haul Road intersection, widen shoulders, and overlay the pavement surface. It is estimated that the entire project should be completed by mid-November, 2010.

Shiloh Rd. One lane of Shiloh Road will be closed during daylight hours between Greenmount Road and St. John. This lane closure is necessary to replace the asphalt surface. Two way traffic will be maintained using signs, flaggers, and traffic control devices. This work is anticipated to be completed by November 16, 2009.

BOND COUNTY

IL 140/127 There will be daytime lane closures at the structure carrying IL 140/127 over Little Shoal Creek, approximately 0.5 miles west of Greenville. These lane closures are necessary to complete stage work to replace the structure. Flaggers will control one-way traffic through the work zone. This lane reduction is necessary to replace the existing bridge. Work on this project is expected to be completed by the Fall of 2009.

CLINTON COUNTY

IL 161 One lane will be closed at the structure carrying IL 161 over Sugar Creek, west of Albers. These lane closures are necessary to perform stage work to replace the structure. Temporary traffic signals will control one-way traffic through the work zone. This lane reduction is necessary to replace the existing bridge. Work on this project is expected to be completed by the summer of 2010.

WASHINGTON COUNTY

IL 177

Lane restrictions will be in place on IL 177, weather permitting. These lane restrictions are necessary to perform pavement patching and pavement resurfacing. The project has an estimated completion date of August, 2010.
