Purpose

The purpose of the Transportation Engineers Association of Missouri shall be to advance the knowledge of transportation engineering and to provide a forum for the continued education of and communication among all parties dedicated to promoting a quality transportation system that serves the public welfare of Missouri.

History

- TEAM was originally known as the Highway Engineers Association of Missouri.
- The organization was created in the early 1900s.
- Official by-laws for the organization were adopted on January 24, 1923.
- 2008 marks the organization's 98th conference.
- In 2003, to more accurately portray the various engineering disciplines that are involved with transportation in Missouri, the organization's by-laws and name were changed by a vote of the general membership to:

Professional Development Hours
