A synopsis of the August 3, 2012 Cost Share/Economic Development Committee Meeting

Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Three projects were approved for approximately \$1.5 million.
- ❑ Three projects are pending and awaiting further information.
- ❑ The Cost Share/Economic Development Program funds available will be determined after receiving information regarding the pending projects.

Partnerships Approved

Boone County - \$555,646 to construct a new three-lane bridge at the I-70 and Route Z interchange and Route Z resurfacing and shoulder improvements.

City of Springfield - \$291,510 to upgrade traffic signal controllers, central control software, controller firmware and cabinet components at all signalized locations on MoDOT maintained routes within and adjacent to the Springfield city limits.

City of O'Fallon - \$601,895 for interchange improvements which eliminates one of the two jug handles from the previously approved cost share application of August 2011 and the removal of the signalized intersection for the right-in/right-out only access.

Partnerships Pending

Clay County – improve the existing interchange at I-35 and Pleasant Valley Road/South Liberty Parkway/Route 69.

City of Joplin – construct a new interchange on I-44 for the Crossroads Business and Distribution Park on the east side of Joplin.

City of Lee's Summit – construct a new diamond interchange at Route 50 and Blackwell Road and outer road improvements to Oldham Parkway, Blue Parkway and Shenandoah Drive.

Looking Ahead

The Cost Share/Economic Development Committee's next meeting is scheduled for November 15, 2012. Applications must be submitted by September 26, 2012.
