STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP).

The proposed improvements provide to resurface the roadway and upgrade existing sidewalk and entrances along the corridor to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. The roadway typical will match the existing configuration of two thru lanes in each direction with turn lanes at intersections and a short section of two-way left turn lane. Typical lane width throughout the corridor is 10 feet, and no shoulders are provided.
