

Pulaski County Bridge Improvements Public Meeting November 1, 2016

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to replace the deck on the Route 7 bridge over the Gasconade River in Pulaski County. The proposed work will improve safety for motorists who use the bridge.

Why is this work necessary?

The bridge is in need of a deck replacement due to deterioration of the existing structure.

How will traffic be affected?

The removal and replacement of the bridge deck will require a full closure of the affected roadway during construction. Motorists will be provided alternate routes around the work areas.

When will the work take place?

The construction will take place between January 9, 2107 and August 1, 2017 at the awarded contractor's discretion. The project allows for a road closure of up to 90 days.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

All work will be done within existing state right of way. No additional right of way will be needed.

What will the project cost?

The cost is approximately \$1.2 million.
