

Phelps County Bridge Replacement Route D Public Meeting June 27, 2017

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to replace the bridge over BNSF Railroad on Route D in Phelps County. The project is located at the south city limit of Jerome.

Why is this work necessary?

The existing structure on Route D was built in 1944 and is 24 feet wide. The deck and substructure of the bridge have deteriorated and are in need of replacement. The new bridge width on Route D will be 28' feet wide.

How will traffic be affected?

The bridge will be built next to the existing roadway so traffic will be unaffected for most of the project. At the tie-in locations where the existing and new roadways meet the road will be closed and detoured for 30 days for construction.

When will the work take place?

The construction will take place between November 6, 2017 and October 1, 2018 at the awarded contractor's discretion.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

Right of Way was required from adjoining property owners for the offset alignment.

What will the project cost?

The total project cost is approximately \$1,530,000.
