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# MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION MEETING HELD IN JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, THURSDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2015

A special meeting of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission was held on Thursday, October 15, 2015, via teleconference at the Missouri Department of Transportation Building, 105 West Capitol Avenue, Jefferson City, Missouri. Stephen R. Miller, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. The following Commissioners were present via teleconference: Lloyd J. Carmichael, Gregg C. Smith, Michael B. Pace, Michael T. Waters, Jr., and Mary E. Nelson.

The meeting was called pursuant to Section 226.120 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended. The Secretary verified that notice of the meeting was posted in keeping with Section 610.020 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.

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Roberta Broeker, Interim Director of the Missouri Department of Transportation; Rich Tiemeyer, Chief Counsel for the Commission; and Pamela J. Harlan, Secretary to the Commission, were present on Thursday, October 15, 2015.

"Department" or "MoDOT" herein refers to Missouri Department of Transportation. "Commission" or "MHTC" herein refers to Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission.

#### CONSIDERATION OF BIDS FOR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS

On behalf of the Director, Eric Schroeter, State Design Engineer, presented the following recommendation pertaining to bids received on federal-aid and state highway and bridge projects during the past month. The below project and bids were presented to the Commission at the October 7, 2015 meeting. The Commission did not take action on call C01 and chose to table that portion of the action item. Following an administrative review, Mr. Schroeter recommended award of call C01 to the lowest responsive bidder for bids received at the September 25, 2015, letting, as recommended and noted in Table I below.
