




Prevailing Types of Crashes in Jasper County

- 3. Other


Crashes where vehicle contacts "other object"





Crash Rate and Severity Analysis

- Jasper County and the I-44 Study Corridor's Fatality Rate is higher than the Missouri State Average for Interstates.

Crashes in which at least one vehicle invloved was a commercial vehicle





Commercial Vehicle Crash Analysis

- Commercial Vehicles account for 28% of the traffic volume in Jasper County, but are only involved in 16% of the crashes.
- Commercial Vehicle crashes tend to be more severe than passenger vehicle only crashes.
