

- * BACKSLOPE DETERMINED BY SOIL SURVEY.
- ** THE FILL SLOPE SHALL BE 6:1 OR FLATTER WHEN THE FILL HEIGHT IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN 2 FEET (I.E., THE OFFSET FROM THE TOE OF FILL TO THE SHOULDER POINT IS A MINIMUM OF 12 FEET). THE SLOPE MAY VARY TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT. FOR FILL HEIGHTS GREATER THAN 2 FEET, THE SLOPE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM SLOPE DETERMINED BY THE SOIL SURVEY.
- *** 4' DITCH DEPTH PREFERRED IF ALTERNATE 18" ROCK BASE IS USED. SIDESLOPE WIDTH SHALL BE 24' FOR 4' DITCH DEPTH.
- **** WHEN CROSS ROAD GOES OVER MAIN ROADWAY, A VARIABLE SLOPE SHALL BE USED FROM RAMP SHOULDER TO MAIN ROADWAY DITCH POINT.
