Route 37 in Barry County.

The proposed improvement includes pavement resurfacing from south of Route 60 to Arkansas State Line and adding turn lanes at various locations. Improvements include addressing a sight distance issue at the intersection of Route BB, installing interactive flashers at the intersection of Route W, a northbound and southbound left turn lane at the intersection of Farm Road 2140, a one-mile northbound passing lane north of Washburn and drainage improvements (box culvert extensions at three locations) between Seligman and Washburn.

Route 54/Business Route 54/Route W in Miller County.

The proposed project is an intersection safety improvement which will replace the existing signal at Route 54 and Business Route 54 with a grade separated interchange. The new interchange will be constructed as a three-quarter diamond with the fourth access utilizing the existing Business Route 54 as an off ramp for westbound traffic. A new connector road will be constructed under Route 54 using two new bridges on Route 54. Roundabouts will be used for intersection control at each end of the connector road and the westbound off ramp. *Dave Silvester, Central District Engineer*

Route 180 in St. Louis County.

The proposed project is to resurface the roadway, improve safety, upgrade existing sidewalk along the corridor to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements and replace signals at seven intersections along the corridor. Route 180 is a principal arterial, with a typical section of two lanes in each direction with a multi-directional center turn lane that generally runs east-west.
