Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to make pavement and sidewalk improvements on Missouri Route 124 and Boone County Route B in Hallsville.

Why is this work necessary?

Resurfacing of Route 124 and Route B is necessary to keep the pavement in good condition. The improved pavement will provide a smoother, safer surface with better traction for motorists. The sidewalk improvements are needed to bring the sidewalks and intersection along Route 124 and Route B into compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. These sidewalk improvements will provide safer access for all pedestrians.

How will traffic be affected?

The milling and asphalt overlay work will be a moving operation with single lane closures. The sidewalk construction will require some sidewalk closures. Some private and commercial entrances will require partial or full closures. Lane drops will be necessary at some intersections during construction. Night work is recommended along Route 124 and Route B to avoid peak traffic volumes.

When will the work take place?

The construction for this project will take place in 2019.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

All pavement work will take place within existing right of way. Some temporary and permanent easements will be needed for the sidewalk improvements.

What will the project cost?

The total cost of the project, which includes similar work in Ashland, is estimated at \$1,600,000.
