Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the informational meeting?

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information on plans to rehabilitate the Missouri Route AC bridge and six other bridges on U.S. Route 63 from Route AC in Boone County to 3 miles north of Route 54 in Callaway County.

The following bridges will be rehabilitated:

- Route AC over Route 63.
- Northbound and southbound bridges over Gans Creek.
- Northbound bridge over Bonne Femme Creek.
- Northbound bridge over Turkey Creek.
- Northbound bridge over Katy Trail.
- Southbound bridge over Cedar Creek.

Why is this work necessary?

The rehabilitation and preventive maintenance of these bridges is necessary to extend the life of the bridges.

How will traffic be affected?

During construction, the Route AC bridge will be closed for up to 60 days during the summer of 2019. The ramps to Route 63 will remain open at the Route AC bridge. Signs will alert motorists of the closed bridge and a detour will be signed during construction. Drivers are asked to seek alternate routes around the construction. All other Route 63 bridges will remain open to one lane of traffic at all times.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be awarded in the spring of 2019, with construction starting in the summer of 2019, and continuing into the spring of 2020.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

No new right of way will be required.

What will the project cost?

The total cost is approximately \$3.9 million.
