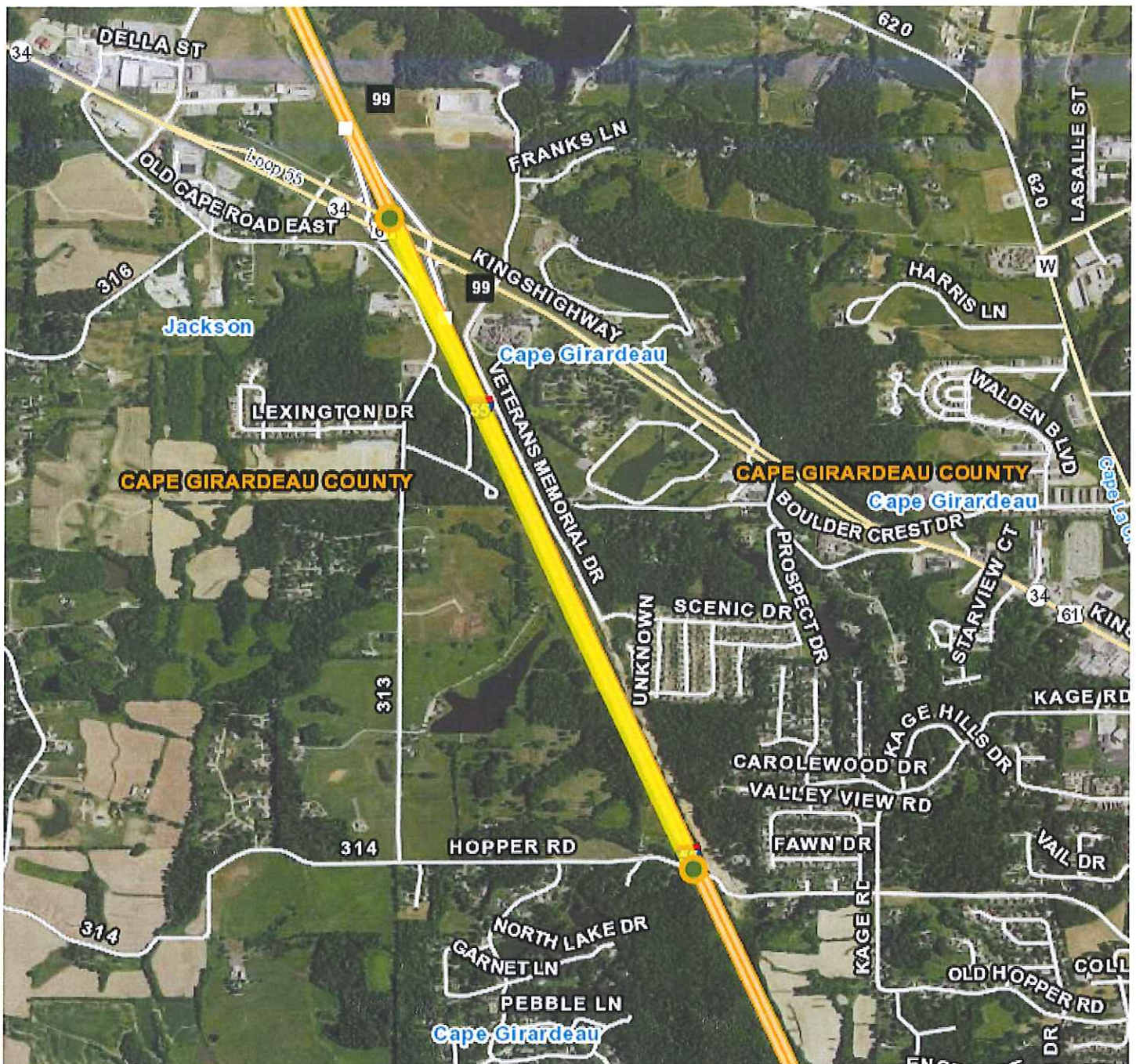

Please see the obituary below for Billy Jack Hogan, Jr.

Funeral services for Sgt. Billy J. Hogan Jr., 21 years old, son of Mrs. Billy Jack Hogan and the late Billy Jack Hogan, will be Thursday at the Ford and Sons Funeral Home.

Burial will be at the Garden of Memories Cemetery at Sikeston. Scott Air Force Base, Belleville, Ill., will hold military graveside rites.

The aircraft maintenance specialist was killed Nov. 29, 1970 in the crash of a U. S. transport plane over South Vietnam. He had been in Vietnam since May and had received basic training at the Lackland Air Force Base in Texas.

Sgt. Hogan was born Oct. 14, 1949, in Sikeston, and had moved to Cape Girardeau in 1963 from Charleston. He graduated in 1967 from Cape Central High School and was employed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Co., for eight month before entering military service.

Survivors besides his mother are two brothers, Mark Hogan and Kevin Hogan; the maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. J. T. Chapman. His father preceded him in death in December, 1967.
