Sealed bids subject to the conditions and provisions presented herein will be received until **2:00 PM local time Tuesday, March 19, 2019,** and then publicly opened and read at **132 David Street, Forsyth, Missouri 65653**, for furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and performing all work necessary to rehabilitate the west apron pavement. Rehabilitation will include full depth reconstruction, mill and overlay and seal coat of existing asphalt pavement.

Addendums to the bid package will be issued through the online Garver Plan Holders List; therefore, all prime bidders shall be responsible for downloading the bid documents from the Garver online plan room in order to be included in the Plan Holders List. Prime bidders should be registered on the Garver Plan Holders List in order to submit a bid on the project.

An optional prebid conference for this project will be held at 10:00 am local time, March 5, 2019 at the M. Graham Clark Downtown Airport, 491 Blue Sky Lane Hollister, Missouri 65672.

Contract Work Items. This project includes, but is not limited to approximately 8,700 square yards of asphalt pavement reconstruction, 4,700 square yards of asphalt mill and overlay, 45,000 square yard of crack seal and seal coat and associated drainage, marking and electrical items.

Contract Time. The owner has established a contract performance time of **120** calendar days from the date of the Notice-to-Proceed. All project work shall be substantially completed within the stated timeframe. This project is subject to liquidated damages as prescribed in the project manual.

Bid Security. No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check on any bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, payable to **Taney County Missouri**, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid, or by a bid bond secured by an approved surety or sureties, payable to the owner, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the total amount of the bid.

Bonding Requirements. The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price at the time of contract execution.

Award of Contract. All proposals submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by Taney County for a period not to exceed **90** from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of conducting the bid evaluation.

Award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum proposal submitted from those bidders that are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. If more than one base bid is listed in the Proposal Form, the bidder shall bid on Base Bid and Additive Alternate. The owner reserves the right to select any one of the combinations of



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the base bid and alternate bid(s), which in the judgment of the owner, best serves the owner's interest. The right is reserved, as Taney County may require, to reject any bid and all bids.

Award of contract is contingent upon the owner receiving State-funding assistance under the State Aviation Trust Fund.

State Wage Requirements. The contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards included in the Supplementary Provisions.

Additional Provisions.

Modification to the project documents may only be made by written addendum by the Owner or Owner's authorized Representative.

The proposal must be made on the forms provided within the bound project manual. Bidders must supply all required information prior to the time of bid opening.
