

The Missouri Department of Transportation is proposing to amend the state's five-year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

A 7-day public comment period regarding the administrative amendment begins March 26, 2019 and ends April 2, 2019. The proposed April administrative amendment is attached below.
