What is FPVS contracting?

FPVS is a contracting method that allows MoDOT to vary the amount of work to be completed to match the project budget.

How does FPVS work?

- The Contractor will bid the projects with the quantities established in the Schedule of Items.
- Award of the contract will be to the lowest responsible bidder.
- MoDOT manages the contract, by adjusting the contract quantities to maximize the use of the budget without exceeding the budget.

Project Specifications for FPVS

- JSP B, Contract Liquidated Damages
 - No Extension of time will be granted due to an increase in quantities
- JSP C (&D) Scope of Work
 - Notes locations of the initial quantities
 - Notes possible locations that could be added if there is remaining budget
 - Establishes budget
 - Contractor is responsible for not exceeding budget

Signing Special Provisions

- Removal of Existing Signs
 - Paid for by each
 - Removal of existing signs should not occur until the new signs have been installed
- Sign Assemblies and Installation
 - Paid for by each sign completely installed
 - Requires the contractor to stake the location of the signs based on the typical layouts provided
 - Requires contractor to pour footings on the same day the hole is excavated.

Signing Special Provisions

- Temporary Traffic Control
 - Requires the contractor to stake the location of the signs based on the typical layouts provided
 - Traffic control to be paid for each ramp, regardless of the number of times used.
 - Partial Ramp Closure, Shoulder Work Ahead and TMA
- Mobilizaton
 - No Direct Pay

Signing Special Provisions

- Bonds
 - Bonds to be based on the budget amount
- Contractor Quality Control
 - Requires submission of weekly reports stating progress of the sign installation
 - Requires submission of photos of completed signs and work area.
