No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check on any bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, payable to **City of Cape Girardeau, MO**, for not less in five (5) percent of the total amount of the total bid amount, or by a bid bond secured by an approved surety or sureties, payable to the owner, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid.

Bids may be held by the **City of Cape Girardeau, MO** for a period not to exceed **NINETY DAYS (90)** from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved by the **City of Cape Girardeau, MO** to reject any bid and also the right to reject all bids.
