Revision – All bidders are hereby instructed to revise paragraph number two that reads "Mobilization is limited to 10 percent of the total project cost." to now read:

"Mobilization is limited to 15 percent of the total project cost."

Each bidder shall submit evidence of competency and evidence 578 of financial responsibility to perform the work to the Owner at the time of bid opening. 579 Evidence of competency, unless otherwise specified, shall consist of statements covering the bidder's past 580 581 experience on similar work, and a list of equipment and a list of key personnel that would be available for the work. 582 583 Each bidder shall furnish the Owner satisfactory evidence of their financial responsibility. Evidence of financial responsibility, unless otherwise specified, shall consist of a confidential statement or report of the bidder's 584 585 financial resources and liabilities as of the last calendar year or the bidder's last fiscal year. Such statements or reports shall be certified by a public accountant. At the time of submitting such financial statements or reports, 586 the bidder shall further certify whether their financial responsibility is approximately the same as stated or 587 reported by the public accountant. If the bidder's financial responsibility has changed, the bidder shall qualify 588 589 the public accountant's statement or report to reflect the bidder's true financial condition at the time such qualified statement or report is submitted to the Owner. 590 591 If the Bidder is presently pre-qualified with the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), evidence 592 593 of this pre-qualification may serve as evidence of financial responsibility in lieu of the certified financial statements and reports. 594 595 Each bidder shall submit "evidence of competency" and "evidence of financial responsibility" to the Owner at 596 the time of bid opening. 597 598 20-03 CONTENTS OF PROPOSAL FORMS. The Owner's proposal forms state the location and 599 description of the proposed construction; the place, date, and time of opening of the proposals; and the 600 601 estimated quantities of the various items of work to be performed and materials to be furnished for which unit bid prices are asked. The proposal form states the time in which the work must be completed, and the amount 602 of the proposal guaranty that must accompany the proposal. The Owner will accept only those Proposals 603 properly executed on physical forms or electronic forms provided by the Owner. Bidder actions that may cause 604 605 the Owner to deem a proposal irregular are given in paragraph 20-09, IRREGULAR PROPOSALS. 606 607 Mobilization is limited to 15 percent of the total project cost. 608 609 A prebid conference is required on this project to discuss as a minimum, the following items: material 610 requirements; submittals; Quality Control/Quality Assurance requirements; the construction safety and phasing 611 plan including airport access and staging areas; and unique airfield paving construction requirements. The pre-612 bid conference for this project will be held on Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at 11:00 a.m., at Airport Conference 613 614 Room. 615 **20-04 ISSUANCE OF PROPOSAL FORMS.** The Owner reserves the right to refuse to issue a proposal 616 617 form to a prospective bidder should such bidder be in default for any of the following reasons: 618 **a.** Failure to comply with any prequalification regulations of the Owner, if such regulations are cited, or 619 otherwise included, in the proposal as a requirement for bidding. 620 621 b. Failure to pay, or satisfactorily settle, all bills due for labor and materials on former contracts in force 622 with the Owner at the time the Owner issues the proposal to a prospective bidder. 623

ITEM 105 MOBILIZATION

105-1 DESCRIPTION. This item shall consist of, but is not limited to, work and operations necessary for the
 movement of personnel, equipment, facilities, material and supplies to and from the project site for work on
 the project except as provided in the contract as separate pay items.

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2722 **105-2 MOBILIZATION LIMIT.** Mobilization shall be limited to 15 percent of the total project cost.

2724 105-3 POSTED NOTICES. Prior to commencement of construction activities, the Contractor must post the 2725 following documents in a prominent and accessible place where they may be easily viewed by all employees of the prime Contractor and by all employees of subcontractors engaged by the prime Contractor: Equal 2726 Employment Opportunity (EEO) Poster "Equal Employment Opportunity is the Law" in accordance with the 2727 Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs Executive Order 11246, as amended; Davis Bacon Wage 2728 Poster (WH 1321) - DOL "Notice to All Employees" Poster; and State Wage Rates from the Project Manual 2729 and Applicable Davis-Bacon Wage Rate Determination. These notices must remain posted until final 2730 acceptance of the work by the Owner. 2731

105-4 ENGINEER/RPR FIELD OFFICE. The Contractor shall provide dedicated space for the use of the field RPR and inspectors, as a field office for the duration of the project. This space shall be located conveniently near the construction and shall be separate from any space used by the Contractor. The Contractor shall furnish water, sanitary facilities, heat, air conditioning, and electricity in accordance with local building codes.

2740 METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

105-5 METHOD OF MEASUREMENT. Partial payments for mobilization will be made once each month
as the work progresses. Provided all requirements of applicable General and Special Provisions have been
accomplished to the satisfaction of the Engineer, partial payments will be made as follows:

- **a.** When 5% of the original contract amount is earned, 20% of the amount bid for this item will be paid, not to exceed 2% of the original contract amount.
- **b.** When 20% of the original contract amount is earned, 50% of the amount bid for this item, less all-previous payments, will be paid, not to exceed 5% of the original contract amount.
- **c.** When 35% of the original contract amount is earned, 60% of the amount bid for this item, less all-previous payments, will be paid, not to exceed 6% of the original contract amount.
 - **d.** When 75% of the original contract amount is earned, the amount bid for this item, less all-previous payments, will be paid, not to exceed 10% of the original contract amount.
- e. When 90% of the original contract amount is earned, the amount in excess of 10% of the original contract amount, less all previous payments, will be paid.

For the purpose of the Specification that term "original contract amount" as used above shall mean the amount of the award for the construction items on this contract not including the amount bid for mobilization. Payments for materials on hand will not be included as a percent of original contract amount earned until said materials on hand have been incorporated into the work and accepted and paid for as contract items. For multiple schedule projects, the above "original contract amount" shall be interpreted by schedule.

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
