The Contract Documents are revised as follows:

CONTRACT PROPOSAL

Pages 3A

REPLACE in the first sentence of the fourth paragraph the words "who desire to submit a bid as a prime contractor shall obtain" with the words "may purchase". The requirement to submit the entire bound project manual is being removed.

Page 5

REPLACE Item 1. with the following:

- 1. The executed proposal form MAY be submitted in the original bound project manual OR pages 123 to 128 may be printed or copied and submitted without the remaining project manual. The E-verify memorandum and Bid Bond shall also be submitted with the proposal.

Page 13

DELETE the second and third sentences of the third paragraph of Section 20-02.

Page 63

REPLACE the Missouri Division of Labor Standards Annual Wage Order No. 25 with the Missouri Division of Labor Standards Annual Wage Order No. 26.

CLARIFICATIONS

In lieu of submitting the entire project manual with the proposal, the proposal form may be printed or copied and submitted without the entire project manual. The pages to be submitted would then be pages 123 to 128 plus the E-verify memorandum and the Bid Bond.

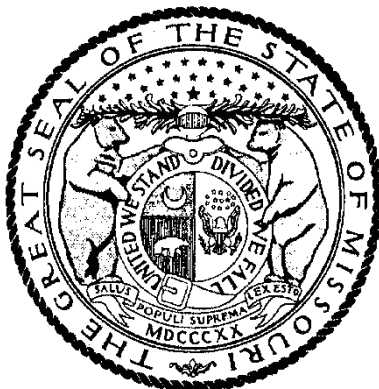

OVERTIME and HOLIDAYS

OVERTIME

For all work performed on a Sunday or a holiday, not less than twice (2x) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work.

For all overtime work performed, not less than one and one-half (1½) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work or contractual obligation. For purposes of this subdivision, "**overtime work**" shall include work that exceeds ten hours in one day and work in excess of forty hours in one calendar week; and

A thirty-minute lunch period on each calendar day shall be allowed for each worker on a public works project, provided that such time shall not be considered as time worked.

HOLIDAYS

January first;
The last Monday in May;
July fourth;
The first Monday in September;
November eleventh;
The fourth Thursday in November; and
December twenty-fifth;

If any holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday.
