Mr. Padgett reported Plan prescription claims costs have increased 6.2% when compared

to 2017 through the eighth month of the 2018 calendar year.

Aetna Quarterly Update- Mr. Padgett welcomed Aetna staff to the meeting.

2nd Quarter Update- Ms. Chadwell and Mr. Moss presented the 2nd Quarter

Update. Mr. Moss reported a 13% increase in claim cost for 2018. This is down

6% from last quarter. There were 21 large claims over \$150,000 that equaled

\$5.6 million. Eight of those claimants have now termed from the Plan

still working closely with Anthem each day and everything has been going smoothly.
