Panic Light Confirmation



Description

The panic light confirmation is light that is mounted to a TMA trailer and can be seen from the driver side mirror. It turns on and off in conjunction with the panic lights on the back of the trailer that are turned on for approaching traffic.

Benefit

Without this confirmation light, the driver cannot see whether or not the lights are on. The remote used to activate the lights uses the same button for on and off, leaving the driver trying to remember how many times the button has been pressed that day or getting out of the vehicle and walking around the back to check the lights which is a very unsafe practice for the driver of a TMA. This confirmation light allows the driver to easily check the mirror to know if the panic lights are on or off.

Materials and Labor

Total cost of materials is \$20 and total amount of time of labor is about 25 minutes.
