Tab Remover



Description

District staff bolted grader blades on the cutting edge of a backhoe loader bucket. A tarp also was attached to the bucket.

Benefit

The tab remover allows employees to safely and quickly remove pavement tabs at up to 15 mph. The tarp keeps tabs in the bucket for easy disposal.

Parts and Labor

1 - 8' motor grader blade

2-4' carbide snow plow blades

1 - 6' x 8' tarp (scrap)

12 feet $-\frac{5}{16}$ " chain

8 – plow bolts

 $2 - \frac{5}{8}$ x 3" side bolts

 $2 - \frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" chain bolts

12 - zip ties

Total: \$430 Labor: 4 hours
